



Frequently Asked Questions – Propolis Vaporizers and Diffusers

1. What is a Propolis Vaporizer / Diffuser?

It's an electrical appliance that vaporizes propolis in a small glass cartridge and diffuses the potent phenolic compounds within it into the air. More than aromatherapy, it's Apitherapy. Watch our video on YouTube.

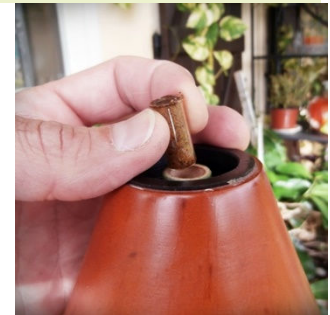
2. How does a Propolis Vaporizer work?

It has a cylindrical-shaped ceramic heating element, calibrated to reach 143 – 185°F (62°-85°C) to release the essential phenolic acids and active flavonoids into the air.

3. What does it need?

- No water
- No oil
- Just electricity

Uses only Propolair refill cartridges, available in 2 formulations – **P+B** (95% propolis, 5% Boswellia serrata) & **BIO** (100% organic propolis). The **Essentials** collection blends organic propolis (80%) with various organic essential oils (20%).



4. Why do I need one?

It's an all-natural, chemical-free way to sanitize a room, eliminating bacteria, mold, viruses and air pollutants. At the same time, you'll be breathing in the therapeutic properties of propolis known for its many virtues. It's also safe to use around pets. Recommended by doctors and therapists for:

- respiratory conditions such as asthma, bronchitis, COPD
- allergies to mold, pollen, mites
- weakened immune systems
- young or elderly people vulnerable to contagions
- areas with lots of humans, i.e. carriers of bacteria, flu, colds, viruses

5. What models are available?

- > Models A - white plastic form
- > Models L - wooden, conic form
- > Propol Therapy – similar to A models, includes 2 masks & tube for inhalation therapy
- > Propolina (Baby Bee) – plastic form of a honey bee
- > Breathe – wooden form, shaped like a beehive
- > Car - plugs into any cigarette lighter

6. How & when do you change cartridges?

The glass cartridges have an approximate life span of 122hrs or 5 days of non-stop usage, which is calculated by an internal timer. Each diffuser has an LED that will blink and beep when it's time to replace the cartridge. 1) Remove the protective grill cover, 2) replace the cartridge and then 3) press the Power button for a full 10 seconds, until you hear a rapid series of beeps. Remove finger from button and unit is ready to continue diffusing propolis.

7. How do you activate the fan?

Activating the fan is automatic for models A3, L3. Once on, the fan cycles on/off automatically. Model A4, Propol Therapy, allows for manual control of the fan for inhalation and room sanitization.
